Sand Hook is a 2,044 acre barrier beach peninsula at the northern tip of the New Jersey shore. It offers pristine beaches, stunning views of the harbor and New York skyline, historical landmarks including decommissioned Fort Hancock and the Sandy Hook Lighthouse, and hundreds of acres of undeveloped shoreline and native coastal habitat.
